New Structure of Unique Identifiers for Software Deliverables

BMC Software is announcing that as of June 30, 2004, the use of FD numbers will be phased out due to the standardization of BMC product identification. Starting with the next release of the following product lines: CONTROL-M, CONTROL-D, CONTROL-O, CONTROL-SA, and CONTROL-V, the structure of the unique identifiers for software deliverables will use a new format. ## Phasing Out FD Numbers

After many years of using FD numbers for identification and communication of BMC products, the use of FD numbers is being phased out to be consistent with BMC standards and to improve the communication related to BMC products.

Existing product versions will continue to be referenced by their FD number, for example, Enterprise SecurityStation version 3.2.02 (an existing version) will continue to be referenced by FD5375. However, the reference for Enterprise SecurityStation version 3.3.00 will be LPH3Y.3.3.00, as explained in [“The New Unique Identifier Format”](#) on page 2.



# The New Unique Identifier Format

The new unique identifier is composed of alphanumeric digits. The format is:

TTCCC.VV.RR.MMM.PPP

where:

- TT is the object type (2 characters - LP for licensed product, PA for patch, etc.)
- CCC is an internal product code (3 alphanumeric characters)
- VV is the version (1-2 numeric characters)
- RR is the release (1-2 numeric characters)
- MMM is the maintenance number (at least 2 digits, no more than 3 digits)
- PPP is the patch ID (for patches only - up to 3 alphanumeric characters)

## Examples

### Example 1

The unique identifier for CONTROL-M Smart Plug-In for HP OpenView version 6.1.03 is LPH2W.6.1.03.

### Example 2

The unique identifier for the first patch that applies to Fix Pack 1 for CONTROL-D for Distributed Systems version 3.2.00 is PADYT.3.2.00.101.

### Example 3

The unique identifier for CONTROL-SA/PassPort version 1.7.00 is LPH4B.1.7.00.
